- 2. Committee Business
  - a. Approval of November 8, 2018 meeting minutes (Beth 1<sup>st</sup>, Kayci 2<sup>nd</sup>, approved.)
- 3. School Events
  - Oquirrh Fest– Report/Feedback (Intermountain Healing Hearts received just under \$19,000, Riverton Holiday Heroes received \$2500, Gordman's/Jordan Ed. Foundation received \$2500.)
  - b. Red Ribbon Week Theme—"It's Never Been Cool to Do Drugs"

- 4. School Business:
  - a. Trust Lands Enrichment
    - i. Enrichment report—Some schools are frustrated with how Reality Town is going at their schools. It is well-run and well-attended at OHMS. Could coordinate with other schools to observe how it is done here. It was suggested that the 9<sup>th</sup> grade students could go to Biz Town. However, there is concern about the cost of the buses, the cost of admission, taking too much time out of the school day, and possible boredom at Biz Town venue.
    - ii. Enrichment ideas—After School Game Group—possibly buy some Wiis, also, badmitton was suggested, can get funding through JEF grants.
  - b. Stem—Two teams for FTC Challenge, Rookie team qualified for State Robotics.
  - c. Technology Update—New set of iPads. Every classroom 1 to 1 except for ART.
  - d. Safe Walking Routes—District creating overlays with the new safe walking routes. Have been given an extension due to the boundary changes and will discuss at the March SCC meeting. Suggested to have a quarterly Skylert about Parking Lot Procedures.

- e. Budget Proposal for next year—Would like to see more funding for Professional Development. Instructional coaching builds comradery and helps the teacher identify strengths and areas that need improvement. Work on developing Teacher Talent. Peer Review Notebook.
